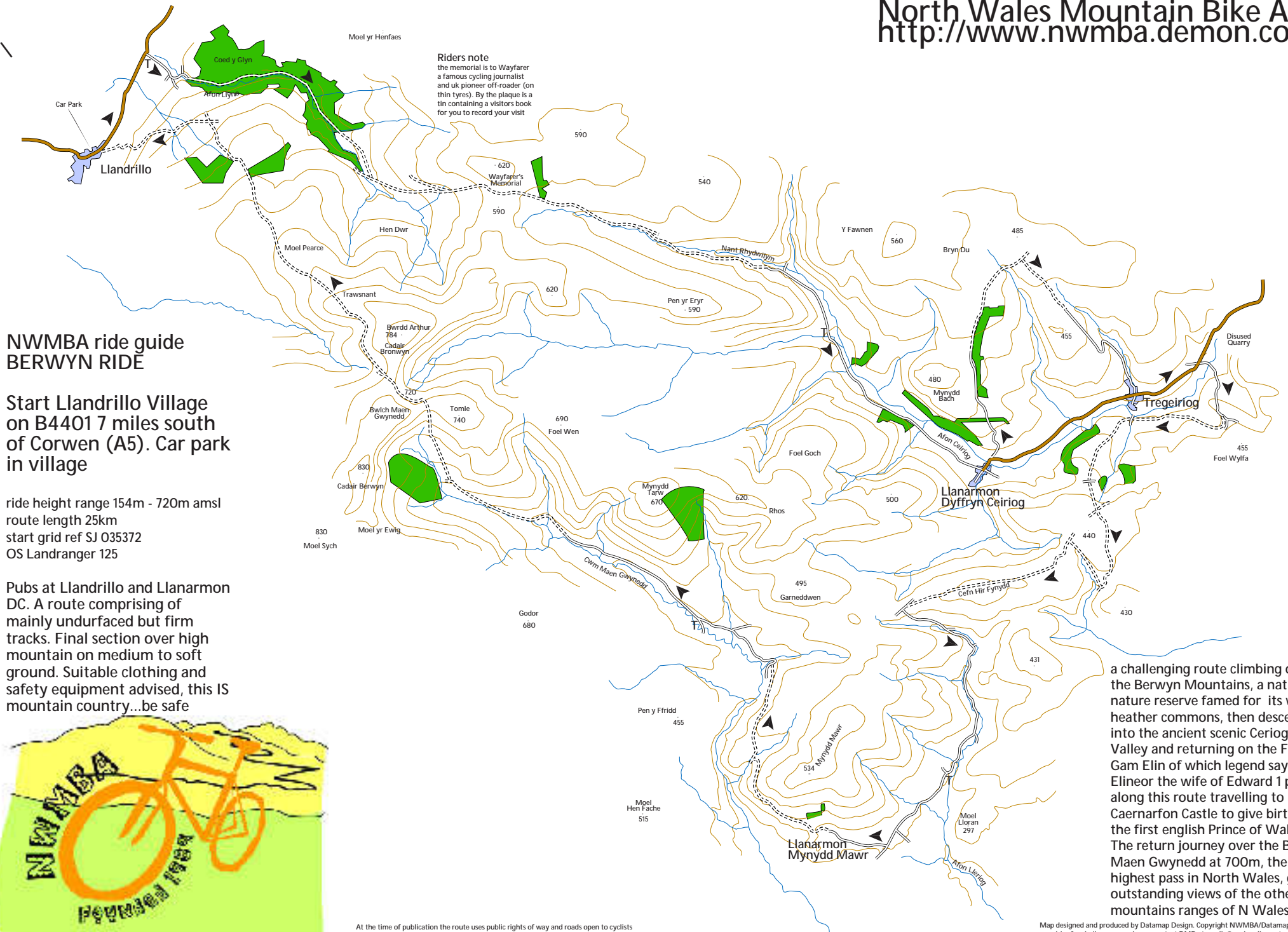


Riders note

**NWMBBA ride guide
 BERWYN RIDE**

Start Llandrillo Village on B4401 7 miles south of Corwen (A5). Car park in village

ride height range 154m - 720m amsl
 route length 25km
 start grid ref SJ 035372
 OS Landranger 125

Pubs at Llandrillo and Llanarmon DC. A route comprising of mainly undurfaced but firm tracks. Final section over high mountain on medium to soft ground. Suitable clothing and safety equipment advised, this IS mountain country...be safe

a challenging route climbing onto the Berwyn Mountains, a national nature reserve famed for its wild heather commons, then descending into the ancient scenic Ceriog Valley and returning on the Ffordd Gam Elin of which legend says Elinor the wife of Edward 1 passed along this route travelling to Caernarfon Castle to give birth to the first english Prince of Wales. The return journey over the Bwlch Maen Gwynedd at 700m, the highest pass in North Wales, gives outstanding views of the other mountains ranges of N Wales



At the time of publication the route uses public rights of way and roads open to cyclists as of right or arising from historical status any subsequent changes are beyond our control
